

Coach Mike Reports: Although the Girls squad was in a rebuilding year, 4 School Records were broken. They finished in 6th place out of 15 teams at the Constitution State Conference (CSC) championship with 45 points, which was the most ever for the UHS girls team. The Boys had their strongest year ever. Eleven (11) School Records were broken, and they finished 2nd out of 18 teams at the CSC championship. At the CIAC 'Class S' Meet the boys finished in 7th place out of 36 teams with 33 points. Their performance was highlighted by the 4x100 meter relay squad (Kadeem Johnson, Johann Charles, Austin McIntosh, and Omar Sewell) taking First Place. Nine (9) athletes advanced to the CIAC State Open, competing in the 100m, 200m, 400m, 4x100m, and 4x800m races.

Also ... from a Hartford Courant Article: Robert "Bob" Niedbala, 65, of Norwich was running his 20th Boston Marathon, but for the first time, he was running unofficially because of a hamstring injury he suffered while training. The injury knocked him out of the race at mile 17, and he learned of the explosions on his car radio while driving home.
